this prophecy...

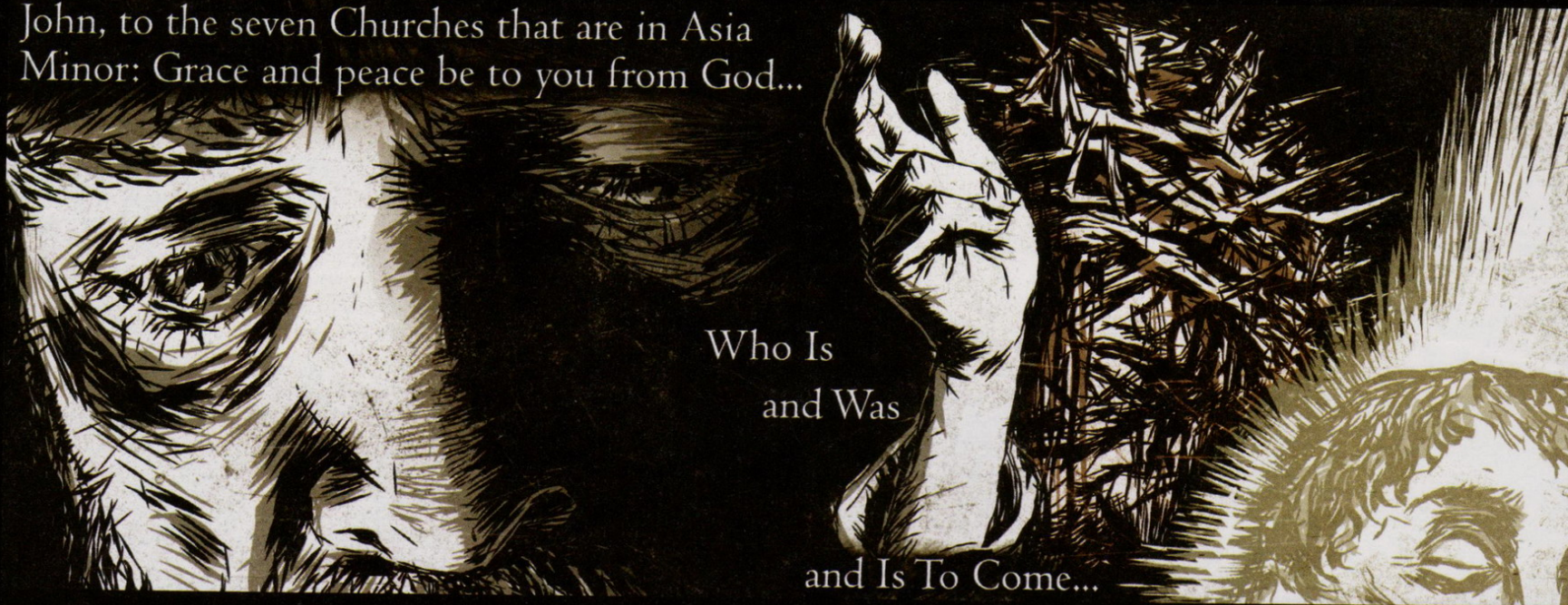
...and diligently observe

Amen!







Behold!

...and every eye will see Him...




...even those who pierced Him.

the Lord's Day...


...and I was enraptured in spirit.

power.

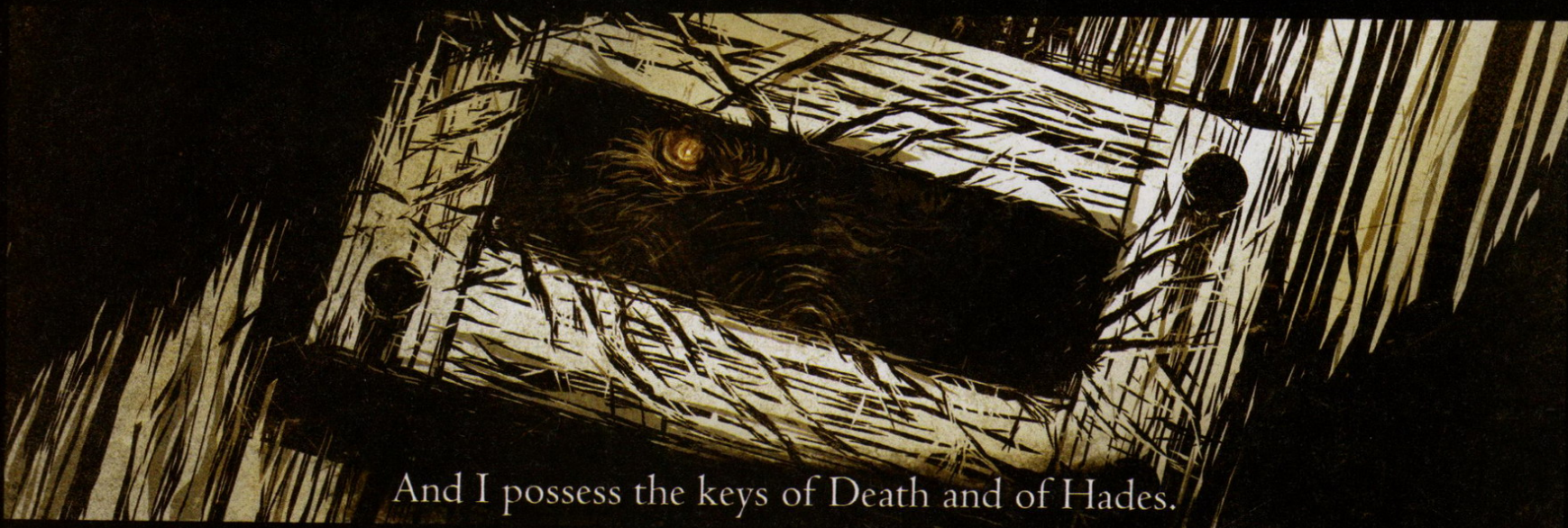




When I saw Him, I collapsed  
at His feet like one dead.

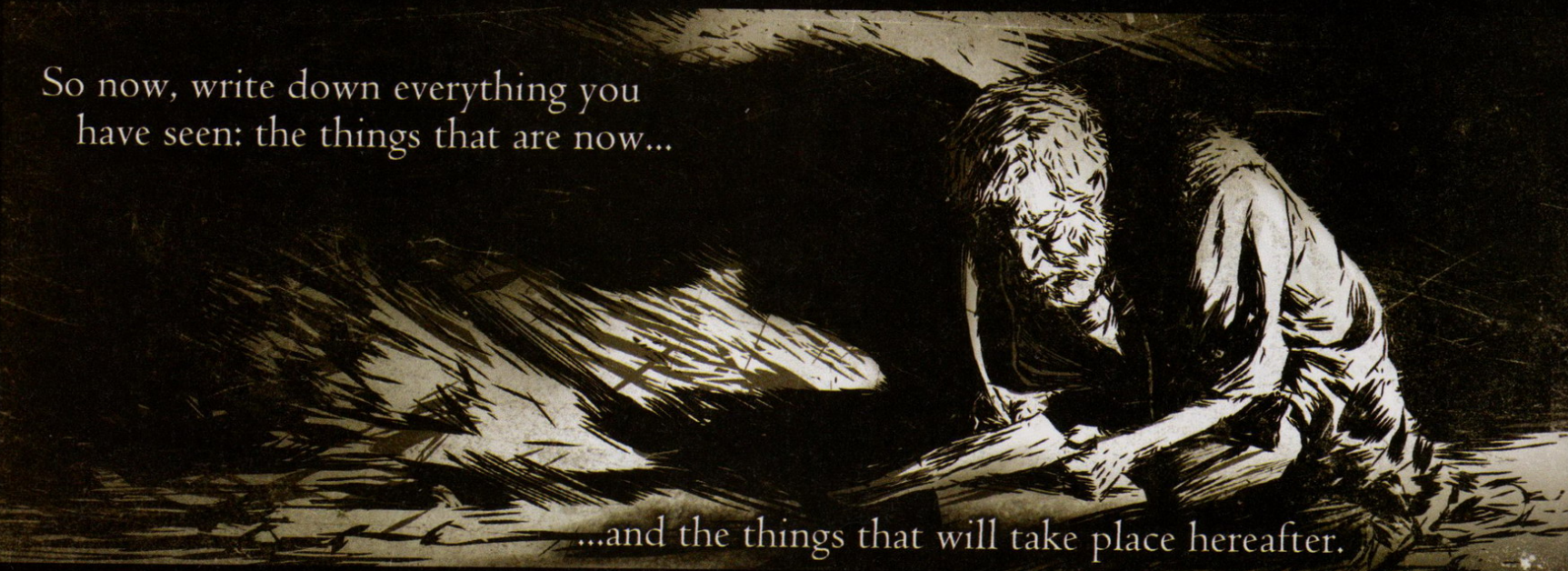
But He laid His right hand upon me and said, "Fear not!
