## What Do The Scores Mean?

We tried to identify your gifts by looking at what you volunteer for, at what people ask you to do, at what you are burdened for, at what you think God has enabled you to do and what you feel God has led you to do. When you put these scores together, it will give a strong indication of what you feel are your Spiritual Gifts. Here is what your scores mean:

- 13-15 Very dominant preference. If you are not already involved in using this gift, you should consider it. We would recommend that you seek a spiritual leader and ask them to confirm this gift in you. You should start to use it in the church if you are not doing so already.
- 10-12 A strong desire to be involved using this gift. It may be that you need more experience; and need others in the church to pray for you about this gift. Start to develop your use of this gift in the church.
- 8-9 Your experience of this gift is not that strong but you are comfortable with it. There will no doubt be occasion when you will be called to use this gift. If there is an interest in this gift and you feel God wants you to explore it more, speak to a leader about it.
- 0-7 You do not feel this is your gift. Perhaps because you do not have much experience in this gift. We are, however, called upon from time to time to be involved in all the Christian virtues of mercy, wisdom, helps, faith... these are part of our everyday Christian living.
